Subject : Tender for Agreement for Management, Operation and Maintenance of the Portion of Ground Floor of Transport Department Vehicle Examination Complex

Description : The successful tenderer will be required to undertake the following duties:

- (a) managing and operating the Portion of Ground Floor of Transport Department Vehicle Examination Complex (the “Centre”) for conducting vehicle roadworthiness examinations for specified types of vehicles;
- (b) inspecting, maintaining and upgrading equipment and facilities for provision of the services under the Agreement;
- (c) inspecting and performing non-structural maintenance of the premises of the Centre;
- (d) performing vehicle examination, issuing vehicle examination reports and repair orders; and
- (e) collecting examination fees and other approved charges for and on behalf of the Government.

The duration of the agreement shall be four (4) years commencing on 1 April 2021 or a date the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region shall specify.

Late tenders or tenders not deposited in the Government Secretariat Tender Box will not be accepted. Following removal of the blockage, the Government will announce the extended tender closing time as soon as practicable. Submission of Tenders/Applications : Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board, and placed in the Government Secretariat Tender Box situated in the Lobby of the Public Entrance on the Ground Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong **before 12:00 noon on Friday, 9 October 2020.**

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any tender, and reserves the right to negotiate with any tenderer about the terms of the offer.
